



Memorandum Of Understanding

Between Techfest, IIT Bombay and Dyal Singh College, Karnal

Association's policies

- Use/mention of any logo, advertisement, website/link, and branding will be done as mutually decided by teams of both parties in writing on an operational basis.
- Any use, mention or placement of IIT Bombay Logo or IIT Bombay name (electronic or physical media) on any advertisement, event, notice, brochure, mailer or branding material will be done only after written approval from IIT Bombay authorities and as per IIT Bombay norms. This policy applies in perpetuity.
- The other terms of this MoU will be applicable till the culmination of Techfest 2021-22 or upon a request for withdrawal by either party, whichever happens, earlier, whereby any commitments till such date will be honored. Further, in addition to the terms of this MoU, Dyal Singh College, Karnal will adhere to IIT Bombay's existing norms, to the extent applicable to it with regard to the event and its conduct at Techfest 2021-22.
- Both parties will work together in good faith with the aim of making the event a grand success and
 each party agrees that, except in the eventuality of gross negligence or flouting of norms by Dyal
 Singh College, Karnal or its representatives/staff, neither will be liable to the other for any kind of
 eventuality or loses that are caused due to associated with holding the event.
- Dyal Singh College, Karnal shall help the coordinator(s) to publicise the Online Session in their institute and bring 100+ participants for the session.
