Our genesis lies in the last Will and Testament of our illustrious founder **Sardar Dyal Singh Majithia**, a great patriot and one of the pioneers of the Indian Renaissance. In accordance with his Will, Dyal Singh College was established on May 3, 1910, with avowed aim that the college "shall in all respects be a thoroughly efficient non-denominational college... teaching up to the highest standards... and looking after the mental well-being of the pupils on its rolls".

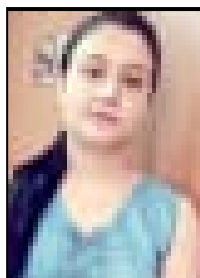

# ADMISSION DETAILS OF UNDER GRADUATE COURSES

## FACULTY OF ARTS

### B.A. (Bachelor of Arts)

**Note: Minimum 10 students are required to run a subject Course**

#### ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- i) A candidate shall be eligible to join the first year (Part-I) of B.A. (General) if he/she has passed one of the following examinations with English as one of the subjects & has also obtained at least 33% marks in aggregate.
- ii) Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 Standard of Board of School Education, Haryana).

OR

Any other examination recognized by the Academic Council as equivalent to (ii) above, with English as one of the subjects and with the prescribed percentage of marks.

A candidate for B.A. (General) Examination shall be required to take up two elective subjects in Part - I from the following elective subjects and same will continue in Part-II and III of the course.

#### (a) COMPULSORY SUBJECTS

1. English
2. Hindi
3. Computer Awareness in B.A. I
4. Environmental Studies in B.A. I

## **FACULTY OF SCIENCE**

### *B.Sc. (Bachelor of Science)*

#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

- i) A candidate shall be eligible to join the First Year (Part-I) class of the B.Sc. (General) if he/she has passed one of the following examinations with English as one of the subject and has also obtained at least 40% marks in aggregate.
- ii) Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 standard) of the Board of School Education, Haryana.  
OR
- i) Any other Examination recognized by the Academic Council as equivalent (ii) above with English as one of the subjects and with prescribed percentage of marks.
- iii) A candidate must have studied in the medical/non- medical stream at the XII level.  
A candidate applying for the B.Sc. Degree Course shall be required to take up the following subjects in each of the Part-I and Part-II:

#### **(a) Compulsory Subjects:**

- (i) English along with the papers of B.Sc. Part-I
- (ii) Hindi/Sanskrit (along with the papers of B.Sc. Part-II)
- (iii) Computer Education for students of B.Sc. (Med), (Non Med.) (Qualifying Paper in B.Sc.-I)
- (iv) Environmental Studies (Qualifying Paper in B.Sc. I)

**Note: A candidate coming from a non-Hindi area or a candidate covered under clause 10[111] of ordinance, General Rules for Examinations, shall, if he/she did not offer Hindi in qualifying examination for admission to B.Sc. can offer (in lieu of compulsory, Hindi/Sanskrit as the subject) Additional English, which shall carry, the same marks as for Hindi/Sanskrit.**

## **BCA (PROFESSIONAL) BACHELOR OF COMPUTER APPLICATIONS**

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

A candidate who has passed 10+2 examination of Board of Education, Haryana or any other examination recognized as equivalent there to with English as the subject and obtaining at least 50% marks in the aggregate, shall be eligible for the course.

## **FACULTY OF COMMERCE**

### *B. Com (Aided, Honours & Vocational)*

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

- i) A candidate who has passed anyone of the following examination with English as one of the subjects shall be eligible to join the First Year (Part-I) class of Bachelor of Commerce Course.
  - ii) Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2) of the Board of School Education, Haryana or an examination recognized by the Academic Council as equivalent thereto with at least 40% marks in the Commerce Group or 50% marks in the Non Commerce (Humanities/Science).
- OR

Any other Examination recognized by the Academic Council as equivalent (ii) above with English as one of the subjects and with prescribed percentage of marks as above.

## POST-GRADUATE COURSES

Postgraduate study undoubtedly builds on the skills acquired at the undergraduate degree level. It develops a new form of maturity. A Post Graduate can further the skills and knowledge in the chosen field. Dyal Singh College Karnal has traversed a long journey upholding its objective of providing quality education in diversified disciplines not only at Under Graduate but also at Post Graduate level.

The College offers Post Graduate Degree Courses in the subjects of English, Hindi, Political Science, Economics, Commerce and Chemistry.

### Eligibility

A candidate who has passed one of the following examinations of the university or an examination recognized as equivalent, there to, shall be eligible for admission to the concerned M.A. First Semester Course.

#### **M.A. (English)**

B.A. (Hons.) in English with 45% marks in aggregate.

OR

Bachelor's degree with atleast 50% marks in aggregate or  
45% marks in the subject of English.

#### **M.A. (Hindi)**

B.A. (Hons.) in Hindi with 45% marks in aggregate.

OR

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with at least 50% marks in aggregate or  
45% marks in the subject of Hindi/Sanskrit  
(Compulsory / Elective)/ Functional Hindi/ Prabhakar.

OR

Shastri examination (new scheme) of three year duration with 45% marks in aggregate.

#### **M.A. (Political Science)**

B.A. (Hons.) in Political Science with 45% marks in aggregate.

OR

B.A. with atleast 45% marks in the subject of Political Science/Public Administration/ Sociology/History /  
Economics.

OR

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with at least 50% marks.



## SELF FINANCING

### M.Sc. (Chemistry)

#### (i) Mathematical Stream

50% of the seats in M.Sc. (Chemistry) shall be filled up by candidates who have passed B.Sc. examination with Chemistry, Mathematics and one other subject at the B.Sc. level with minimum 50% marks in aggregate.

#### (ii) Non- Mathematical Stream

50% of the seats in M.Sc (Chemistry) shall be filled up by the candidates who have passed B.Sc. examination with at least 50% marks in aggregate with Chemistry and any two other subjects except Mathematics at B.Sc. level.

### M.Com.

B.Com./BBA/BTM/BIM/Bachelor of Arts/Science with Economics/Mathematics with 45% marks in aggregate.

### M.Sc. Forensic Science (5-Year Integrated Course)

The college offers a 5-year Integrated M.Sc. Programme in Forensic Science sponsored by UGC under Innovative Programme. All through Haryana our college is the only one to offer this integrated course in Forensic Science. It is a unique programme that offers to the students different careers in the field of Crime Investigation, Forensic Science Provision, Police Recruitment, Cyber Crime Experts, Policy Making and Public Sector Careers such as Civil Services in addition to normal Graduate and Post-graduate Courses. The entry to this course is after passing 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics subjects with English as one of the subjects.

#### (i) Non-medical Stream

50% of the seats in M.Sc. Forensic Science (5-Year Integrated Course) shall be filled up by candidates who have passed 10+2 examination with English, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics subjects at the 10+2 level with minimum 50% marks in aggregate.

#### (ii) Medical Stream

50% of the seats in M.Sc. Forensic Science (5-Year Integrated Course) shall be filled up by candidates who have passed 10+2 examination with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects at the 10+2 level with minimum 50% marks in aggregate.

(iii) Lateral Entry in 7<sup>th</sup> semester of this course is also available for a candidate, who has passed B.Sc. with Forensic Science as subject or B.Sc. (Hons.) Forensic Science from any recognised University.

### ADD-ON-COURSES

The college offers short term add-on-courses to supplement learning in Arts & Science and to provide an opportunity to the students of the college to sharpen the areas of enquiry that are the buzz for today. The main objective of these courses is to impart skills which the students require to sharpen their knowledge and awareness to deal with the present competition in various fields. Presently, the college offers Add-on-Courses in Bio-informatics (Certificate & Diploma Courses), Software Internet & Web Programming (Web Designing) & Computational Physics.

1. Bio-informatics (Certificate & Diploma Courses)

# Our Special Features

## Admission Policy

A set of guidelines apply for admitting students to various courses. The philosophy of the college is to provide rule based, transparent administration which is reflected in its admission policy also. The entire admission policy is in accordance with the guidelines and schedule prescribed by Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. The policy of reservation as prescribed by the University is strictly followed.

## Attendance Policy

Every teacher maintains attendance register where the lecture-wise attendance of the students is registered. The attendance records are consolidated term-wise and the shortage of lectures, if any, is displayed on the Notice Board and the College website. The parents are informed about the attendance of their wards in case of default. The attendance is consolidated further at the end of each term and the defaulting students are alerted / sensitised well in advance about the need to keep the required (75%) attendance by the end of the academic semester.

## Teaching Calendar and Teaching Aids

As per the University requirements we ensure 180 days of teaching in an academic year. For this the college calendar is prepared at the beginning of every semester. The classes start the very next day after the admission process is complete. If teaching days are lost due to unavoidable, unpredictable conditions beyond our control, we take care to make up for those days. Many of our co-curricular activities / functions are conducted in the afternoons so as to minimize the loss of teaching.

To enhance the effectiveness of class room teaching, the college has obtained a variety of modern teaching aids. Teachers are encouraged to develop and use students participatory methods of teaching. In addition to the traditional lecture and chalk and duster system, teachers encourage seminars, paper presentation, quiz, etc. Students are guided to make charts and posters on the topics from the syllabii. These charts and posters are then displayed in the class rooms and laboratories.

Thus, while on one hand we insist on compulsory attendance of students, on the other hand the college and the faculty try their best to make class room teaching effective for the students.
