INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

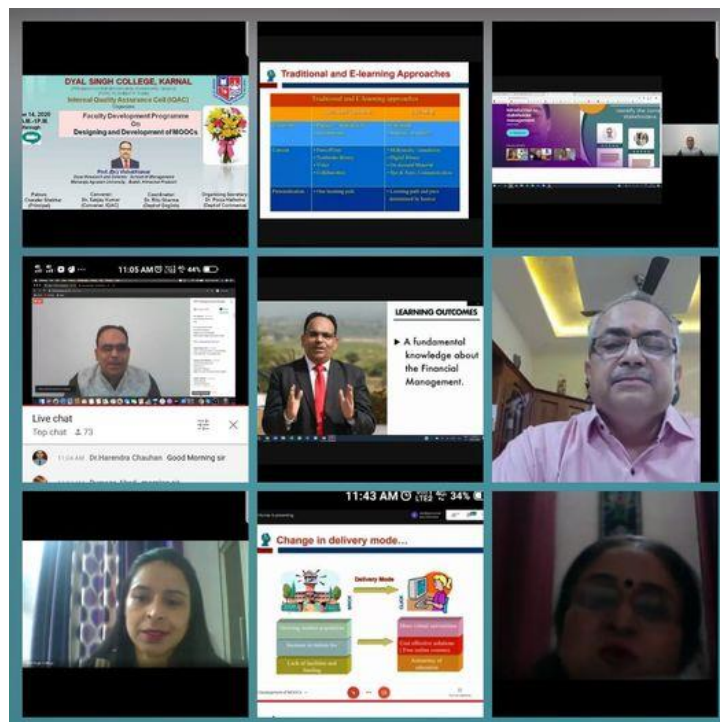
