THE CONCEPT:

The National Service Scheme was started to establish a meaningful linkage between the campus and the community. Mahatma Gandhi, the Father of the Nation, had recognized that the country could not progress in a desired direction until the student youth were motivated to work for the upliftment of the villages/community. For Gandhiji the villages, where majority of the population lived, represent the country i.e. India. Therefore, for the national reconstruction and national resurgence it was deemed fit that the students and teachers should be properly sensitized and utilized for strengthening the Indian society as a whole with particular emphasis on rural community. Therefore, the University Grants Commission headed by Dr. Radhakrishnan recommended introduction of national service in the academic institutions on a voluntary basis with a view to developing healthy contacts between the students and teachers on the one hand and establishing a constructive linkage between the campus and the community on the other hand. The student youth, teachers and the community are considered the three basic components of the National Service Scheme.

The idea was considered by the Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE) at its meeting held in January, 1950. After examining the various aspects of the matter and in the light of experience of other countries in this field, the Board recommended that students should devote some time to manual work on a voluntary basis and that the teachers should also associate with them in such work. In the draft First Five year Plan adopted by the Government of India in 1952, the need for social and labour service for students for one year was further stressed. In 1958, the then Prime Minister Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru in his letter to the Chief Ministers, mooted the idea of having social service as a prerequisite for graduation. He further directed the Ministry of Education to formulate a suitable scheme for introduction of national service into the academic institutions. Further, a National Service Committee was appointed under the Chairmanship of Dr. C.D. Deshmuklh on August 28, 1959 to make concrete suggestions in this direction. The committee recommended that national service for a period of nine months to a year may be made compulsory for all students completing high school education and intending to enroll themselves in a college or a university. In 1960, at the instance of the Government of India, Prof. K.G. Saiyidain studied national service by students implemented in several countries of the world and submitted his report under the title "National Service for the Youth" to the Government with a number of recommendations as to what could





be done in India to develop a feasible scheme of social service by students. The Education Commission headed by Dr. D.S. Kothari (1964-66) recommended that students at all stages of education should be associated with some form of social service. This was taken into account by the State Education Minister during their conference in April 1967 and they recommended that at the university stage, students could be permitted to join the National Cadet Corps (NCC) which was already in existence on a voluntary basis and an alternative to this could be offered to them in the form of a new programme called the National Service Scheme (NSS). The Vice Chancellors' Conference in September, 1969 welcomed this recommendation and suggested that a special committee of Vice Chancellors could be set up to examine this question in detail. In May, 1969, a conference of the students' representatives of the universities and institutions of higher learning convened by the Ministry of Education and the University Grants Commission also unanimously declared that national service could be a powerful instrument for national integration.

It was stipulated that the NSS programme should be started as a pilot project in select institutions and universities. On September 24, 1969, the then Union Education Minister Dr. V.K.R.V. Rao, launched the NSS programme in 37 universities covering all States and simultaneously requested the Chief Ministers of States for their cooperation and help. It was appropriate that the programme was started during the Gandhi Centenary Year as it was Gandhiji who inspired the Indian youth to participate in the movement for Indian independence and the social uplift of the downtrodden masses of our nation.

The response of students to the scheme has been quite encouraging. Starting with an enrollment of 40,000 students in 1969, today NSS has about 3.86 million student youth enrolled in 41,442 NSS units spread over through 396 Universities/ +2 Councils, 16,331 Colleges/ Technical Institutions and 28,621 Senior Secondary Schools across the country.

THE AIM:

The overall aim of National Service Scheme as envisaged earlier, is to give an extension dimension to the higher education system and orient the student youth to community service while they are studying in educational institution. The reason for the formulation of this objective is the general realization that the college and +2 level students have a tendency to get alienated from the village/slum masses which constitute the majority of the





population of the country.

The educated youth who are expected to take the reins of administration in future are found to be unaware of the problems of the village/slum community and in certain cases are indifferent towards their needs and problems. Therefore it is necessary to arouse the social conscience of the students, and to provide them an opportunity to work with the people in the villages and slums. It is felt that their interaction with the common villagers and slum dwellers will expose them to the realities of life and bring about a change in their social perception.

OBJECTIVES:

- i. Understand the community in which they work
- ii. Understand themselves in relation to their community
- iii. Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving process
- iv. Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility
- v. Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solution to individual and community problems
- vi. Develop competence required for group living and sharing of responsibilities
- vii. Gain skills in mobilizing community participation
- viii. Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitude
- ix. Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters
- x. Practice national integration and social harmony.

THE MOTTO:

The motto or watchword of the National Service Scheme is 'NOT ME BUT YOU'. This reflects the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for selfless service and appreciation of the other person's point of view and also to show consideration for fellow human beings. It underlines that the welfare of an individual is ultimately dependent on the welfare of society on the whole. Therefore, it should be the aim of the NSS to demonstrate this motto in its dayto-day programme.

NSS SYMBOL:

The symbol of the National Service Scheme, as appearing on the cover page of this Manual is based on the 'Rath' wheel of the Konark Sun Temple situated in





Orissa. These giant wheels of the Sun Temple portray the cycle of creation, preservation and release, and signify the movement in life across time and space. The design of the symbol, a simplified form of the Sun-chariot wheel primarily depicts movement. The wheel signifies the progressive cycle of life. It stands for continuity as well as change and implies the continuous striving of NSS for social transformation and upliftment.

NSS BADGE:

The NSS symbol is embossed on the NSS badge. The NSS volunteers wear it while undertaking any programme of community service. The Konark wheel in the symbol has eight bars which represent the 24 hours of the day. Hence, the badge reminds the wearer to be in readiness for service of the nation round the clock i.e. for 24 hours. The red colour in the badge indicates that the NSS volunteers are full of blood i.e. lively, active, energetic and full of high spirit. The navy blue colour indicates the cosmos of which the NSS is a tiny part, ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind.

NSS DAY:

NSS was formally launched on 24th September, 1969, the birth centenary year of the Father of the Nation. Therefore, 24 September is celebrated every year as NSS Day with appropriate programmes and activities.

NSS SONG:

During Silver Jubilee Year the NSS theme song has been composed. All NSS volunteers are expected to learn the theme song and sing the song during NSS programmes and celebrations. The theme song cassette is available and the theme song is given in the end of the Manual.

AIMS OF NSS PROGRAMMES/ACTIVITIES:

The operational aim of NSS is to integrate the three basic components of the programme. NSS programme should provide a variety of learning experiences which must develop a sense of participation, service and achievement among the volunteers. The activities should aim at the following:

i. Making education more relevant to the present situation to meet the felt needs of the community and supplement the education of the university/college students by bringing them face to face with the rural situation.





- ii. Providing opportunities to the students to play their role in planning and executing development projects which would not only help in creating durable community assets in rural areas and urban slums but also results in the improvement of quality of life of the economically and socially weaker sections of the community.
- iii. Encouraging students and non-students to work together along with the adults in rural areas.
- iv. Developing qualities of leadership by discovering the latent potential among the campers, both students as well as local youth (Rural and Urban), with a view to involve them more intimately in the development programme and also to ensure proper maintenance of the assets created during the camps.
- v. Emphasizing dignity of labour and self-help and the need for combining physical work with intellectual pursuits.
- vi. Encouraging youth to participate enthusiastically in the process of national development and promote national integration, through corporate living and cooperative action. While undertaking these activities, each NSS unit should envisage its programmes/activities aimed at instilling discipline, building character, promotion of physical fitness and development of culture.

CLASSIFICATION OF NSS PROGRAMME:

NSS activities have been divided in two major groups.

- i. Regular NSS Activity: Under this, students undertake various programmes in the adopted villages, college/school campuses and urban slums during weekends or after college hours. Duration of these services is 120 hours.
 - a. Orientation of NSS volunteers: To get the NSS volunteers acquainted with the basics of NSS programmes, 20 hours are allocated for their orientation through lectures, discussions, field visits and audio-visuals etc.
 - b. Campus Work: The NSS volunteers may be involved in the projects undertaken for the benefit of the institution and students concerned. Such projects cover development of play grounds, laying of gardens, tree plantation in the premises, awareness programmes on drug-abuse, AIDS, population education and other projects.





The NSS volunteers may work on campus projects for not exceeding 30 hours in a year.

- c. The remaining 70 hours will be utilized for community service on the projects in adopted villages/urban slums independently or in collaboration with others in this field, as detailed below:
 - Institutional work: The students may be placed with selected voluntary organisations working for the welfare of women, children, aged and disabled outside the campus.
 - Rural Project: The rural projects generally include the working of NSS volunteers in adopted villages for eradication of illiteracy, watershed management and wasteland development, agricultural operations, health, nutrition, hygiene, sanitation, mother and child care, family life education, gender justice, development of rural cooperatives, savings drives, construction of rural roads, campaign against social evils etc.
 - Urban Projects: In addition to rural projects other include adult education, welfare of slum dwellers, training in civil defence, traffic control, setting up first-aid posts, work in hospitals, orphanages, destitute home, environment, population education, drug, AIDS awareness, and income generation projects etc. Professional and technical institutions having NSS may have to design appropriate programmes for the community based on the needs.
 - Natural calamities & National Emergencies: The NSS units are expected to utilize the services of NSS volunteers at the time of natural calamities and national emergencies for mobilizing public support and rendering necessary assistance to the authorities in rescue, relief and rehabilitation. In such emergencies and calamities the Programme Officers are expected to take the initiative and offer the services of the NSS units and its volunteers to assist the administration.
 - National Days and Celebrations: The National Service Scheme programmes also include the celebration of National days. The purpose of such a provision is to celebrate such occasions in a befitting manner. In the development perspective of any nation, certain programmesassumes





special relevance in view of problems existing or anticipated. In our country, three such programmes have been launched. They are the Mass Programme of Functional Literacy, AIDS Awareness Programme and Sustainable Development with emphasis on Watershed Management & Wasteland Development. It is pertinent to mention here that NSS Volunteers have come forward with zeal to make these programmes a great success.

ii. Special Camping Programme: Under this, camps of 10 days duration are organised in adopted villages or urban slums during vacations with some specific projects by involving local communities. 50% NSS volunteers are expected to participate in these camps.

In light of the above, the National Service Scheme Units of Dyal Singh College, Karnal always tried to build an environment that not only enhances the feeling of social responsibility but also gives the volunteers an encouragement to become a 'VOLUNTEER' in real sense. The volunteers are always guided in advance about the rules and regulations of NSS and the activities to be under taken through-out the year as per the directions of the Ministry of Youth Welfare and Sports. The college always tries to conduct each and every activity as per the norms mentioned in the NSS manual, 2006.

At Dyal Singh College, Karnal we have three Units named as Unit-56, Unit-57 and Unit-58. About 300 volunteers are enrolled who are always ready to initiate for any kind of services. Through-out the year all the three units conducted several activities. The detailed description of the activities is as follows:

NSS ACTIVITIES DURING THE YEAR 2021-22

NSS units of Dyal Singh College Karnal performed the following activities during the session:

- 1. Enrollment: New N.S.S volunteers were enrolled from 9th October 2021 15th November 2021.
- 2. Celebrated Independence Day: Independence Day was celebrated in college campus on August 15, 2021. The National flag was hoisted by Principal Sh. Sanjay Sharma. About 132 NSS volunteers actively participated during the function. Afterwards NSS volunteers cleaned the college and tree plantation was also done on the same day.
- 3. Orientation Programme N.S.S programme officers Dr. Dimple Khosla, Dr. Tejpal, and Dr. Rubi attended an Orientation Programme organized by Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra on 2nd September 2021.
- 4. Orientation Programme: on 22ndSeptember 2021, a four hours Orientation Programme was done for the old NSS volunteers to make them remind the real meaning of a volunteer. Students were filled with a fresh enthusiasm towards their role in building the nation. PO Dr. Tejpal motivated and guided the volunteers for working more harder than before. A pledge for "Catch the Rain: When it falls and where it falls" was also taken on the same day.
- 5. NSS DAY Celebration: On 24th September, under the "Aazadi ka Amrit Mahotsav Program" National Service Scheme Foundation Day was celebrated in Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra. 12 volunteers of our college participated in the same along with Dr. Tejpal and Dr. Rubi.
- 6. Help Desk:NSS unit established a Help Desk during the admission days and guided students through Help Desk for admissions and resolved their queries.
- 7. Covid Vaccination Camp: A Covid Vaccination Camp was organised in the college campus on 6thOctober, 2021 for the students who were not vaccinated or partially vaccinated. About 140 volunteers got benefited from the camp.





- 8. Around 120 NSS volunteers participated in Prestigious IIT Bombay, Online TechfestNidan: Breast Cancer Awareness Sessions on October 8th -10th, 2021. A MOU was also signed with Techfest, IIT Bombay for future awareness programmes.
- 9. NSS team of around 110 volunteers visited Mangal Sen Auditorium for the program 'Sajda' a musical programme organised by DistrictAdministration, Karnal on 9th November, 2021 under post Covid stress management scheme.
- 10. Awareness Rally: About 130 NSS volunteers along with Legal Literacy Cell and NCC cadets conducted an awareness rally on 12th November, 2021 under the theme "Azaadi ka Amrit Mahotsav".
- 11. Awareness Programme on NashaMukt Bharat: on 25thNovember 2021, as per the directions of Haryana Government, under the aegis of Narcotics Control Bureau and under the NashaMukt Bharat Abhiyaan (NMBA) an awareness program was organized. It was organized with the objective of educating the youth to cooperate in achieving the goal of a sustainable world free of substance abuse. Dr. Ashok Kumar, Deputy Inspector of Haryana State Narcotics Control Bureau was the speaker of the day.
- 12. Celebration of Constitution Day: NSS programme officers and about 170 volunteers, along with college teaching staff, non-teaching staff and students took a pledge to observe Constitution Day on 26 November, 2021.
- Around 135 NSS volunteers participated in Prestigious IIT Bombay, Online Techfest Drishti: Eye Donation Awareness Session on November 28, 2021. A separate MOU was also signed with Techfest, IIT Bombay for future awareness programmes.
- 14. Dyal Singh College, Karnal mourns on the unfortunate demise of the Chief of Defense Staff (CDS) General Bipin Rawat and his wife Mrs. Madhulika Rawat and all the 11 Great Warriors that were killed in a helicopter crash in Coonoor, Tamil Nadu on 08.12.2021. On this occasion College Principal Dr Ashima Gakhar, college staff members, NSS volunteers and NCC cadets paid humble and heartfelt floraltribute and observed two minutes silence for the peace of the souls of all the martyred soldiers.





- 15. Three-day International Gita Mahotsav 2021:About 210 NSS Volunteers of Dyal Singh College from all units registered their presence in the 'Threeday International Gita Mahotsav 2021' from December 12-14, 2021 in Panchayat Bhawan, Karnal. Our three volunteers were honoured in this function for their contribution in dance & poetic recitation.
- 16. On December 14, 2021, Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan organised Block Level and then District Level Declamation Competition on "Patriotism and Nation Building"Our Students Renu and Garima stood second and third respectively at block level and Garima got second position at District Level. She received a certificate of appreciation and a cash prize of Rs 2000.
- 17. An awareness session was conducted on December 16, 2021 from the vigilance department to inform the students about the traffic rules. Sh. Rajesh Sharma, District Traffic In-charge guided the students.
- 18. Blood Donation and Covid Vaccination Camp: On December 29, 2021, NSS units of Dyal Singh College, Karnal in association with Youth Red Cross and Red Ribbon Club organised Blood Donation Camp and COVID Vaccination Camp at College Auditorium. Chief Medical Officer, Karnal Dr. Yogesh Sharma was the Chief-guest on this occasion. A total of 77 unitswere donated and 217 students were vaccinated during the camp.
- Volunteers of NSS, Dyal Singh College, Karnal participated in the virtual 25thNational Youth Festival organised on January 12-13, 2022 at Puducherry to mark the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekanand ji.
- 20. NSS Volunteers participated in the mega event of performing Surya Namaskaar on the eve of Makar Sankrati on January 15, 2022. This activity was performed regularly for a period of next 21 days under #75croreSuryaNamaskar campaign.
- 21. ParakramDiwas: On January 23, 2022, ParakramDiwas was celebrated by giving tribute to Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose. About 76 volunteers attended the programme online. Dr. Basant Kumar, former Head of Sanskrit Department of the college was the keynote speaker.
- 22. National Girl Child Day: On January 24, 2022, the NSS Units of Dyal Singh College, Karnal organized a lecture on "Nutrition of Girl Child".Keynote speaker CA Manisha Saluja, renowned dietitian gave various tips on the health of girls and women. On the same day a





campaign was run with #selifewithdaughter in which a large number of NSS volunteers participated by sending their pictures. About 106 volunteers attended the programme online.

- 23. National Voters Day: On this occasion NSS units of Dyal Singh College, Karnal organised an online lecture on the Topic: 'Indian Electoral System: Issues and Challenges'. Ms. Anu, Assistant Professor of Political Science delivered the talk. About 127 volunteers actively participated and also took pledge on the day.
- 24. Republic Day: 73rd Republic Day was Celebrated at Dyal Singh College, Karnal on January 26, 2022. On this occasion, about 153 volunteers actively participated in the function. Thereafter, volunteers of the college also distributed winter clothes in the slum areas of Karnal.
- 25. Vaccination Drive: NSS units of Dyal Singh College, Karnal organised Vaccination Drive for the students their parents and staff of the college on February 1, 2022.
- 26. Two Day Camp was organized on February 14-15,2022 during the Annual Athletic Meet of the College. About 164 volunteers did all the cleaning and preparation of the sports ground day before sports and also painted all the flag poles. NSS volunteers during their both days of theNSS camp arranged a Help-Desk for the First Aid of the players who got hurt while participating in the events. Volunteers also actively participated in various sports events and one of the NSS Volunteers Vijeta of B.Com 5th Semester won the trophy of Best Athlete.
- 27. About 30 volunteers along with Dr. Rubi,NSS program officer attended a program on Women's Day organised by Haryana State Women Commission in Mangal Sen Auditorium on March 4, 2022. The program was focused on Women Empowerment, and to tell students about various rights and laws.
- 28. Around 106 volunteers of NSS, Dyal Singh College, Karnal participated in AasPados Youth Parliament organised by Nehru Yuva Kendra on March 15, 2022 at Kalidas Rangshala on the topic "Beti Bachao Beti Padhao" "NEP" "Atamnirbhar Bharat". They received medal and certificates there.





- 29. On April 16, 2022, a mock drill was organized by NSS Units at college campus under Fire Service Safety Week. During this program, the Haryana Fire and Emergency Service Department gave information related to fire safety precautions, its control and a demonstration on the same to the volunteers and staff of the college in detail. About 132 volunteers participated in the activity and learned to operate various fire safety equipments.
- 30. Seven Day Special Camp at Village Dabri (From April 27 to May 3, 2022)

Day-1

- NSS Volunteers and the Programme Officers left for the camp at Village Dabri from the college after the blessings of Principal Dr. Ashima Gakhar.
- Volunteers and the Programme Officers reached Langar Hall, Dabri and welcomed by the people of the village.
- The camp venue i.e., Langar Hall was cleaned thoroughly and decorated with banners and posters made by the volunteers.
- After that the plan for the activities to be carried out during sevenday camp was discussed in the guidance of Programme Officers, clearly explaining the theme "Atamnirbhar Bharat"
- The Programme Officers assigned different responsibilities to the volunteers after dividing them in to 10 teams. Each team was assigned a team leader and two overall leaders were also appointed.
- NSS Uniform (T-Shirt and Cap) was distributed to all the volunteers.
- Volunteers interacted with the people of the village and got acquainted with their daily routine and lifestyle.

Day-2

- The second day's activities of the camp started with Hawanby Shri Dev Raj Arya and Dr. Basant Kumar.

- In the evening session, Dr. Anita Agrawal, former NSS Program Officer, while speaking on youth empowerment said that youth will have to provide a new direction by making positive changes in the society with their energy and progressive thinking.
- Former Program Officer Dr. Jai Kumar said that the Youth plays a huge role in building of a nation. The motto of the National Service Scheme is "Not Me But You" teaches us that we have to do first for the society, not for ourselves.
- Cultural presentations were made during night by the male volunteers.

Day-3

- The third day's activities of the camp started with the prayer, yoga and meditation.
- A social and economic survey of about 200 houses was conducted by volunteers in the village.
- Dr. Kapil Gulati gave his lecture on Plastic Waste Management. He said that plastic was a boon for mankind which has turned into a curse. He also encouraged the volunteers to find employment opportunities in Plastic Waste Management.
- College alumnus Wajid Sijohan (Karate Trainer Black Belt) explained various protective measures to the girl students in detail and made them practice the tricks of safety. He told the girl students that no equipment or weapons are required for selfdefense. With a little care, vigilance, and self-confidence, we can avoid any accident.
