After independence it was re-established in Karnal in 1949 by Dewan Anand Kumar ji- a great academician and former Vice Chancellor of Punjab University. The college boasts of having been founded by great academician and visionary philanthropist, Sardar Dyal Singh Majithia, the founder of The Tribune. Nestled in the historic building, Umar Manzil, the dwelling of Liakat Ali Khan during pre-partition days, the college has a beautiful ambience with sprawling lawns, playgrounds, an imposing library, and well-equipped labs. The college maintains a rare blend of tradition and modernity with a dedicated Trust, a dynamic Principal and highly qualified Faculty, that enables its students to gather the "Wisdom of the East and the West."

The college has a strength of over 3000 students and has all the three streams of learning-Arts, Science and Commerce with Post-Graduate courses in English, Hindi, Political Science, Commerce and Chemistry in addition to add-on-courses in Bioinformatics, Web Designing and Computational Physics. The college also offers a 5-year-Integrated Course in M.Sc. Forensic Science under innovative programme sponsored by the UGC.
