
ACTIVITIES OF NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

SEMINAR REPORT

NSS units of Dyal Singh College, Karnal organized a one day National Seminar on the topic "मारत को स्वावलम्बी बनाने में राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना का योगदान" 'Role of NSS in making India Self Reliant" sponsored by Director General Higher Education, Haryana. The Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan (Self-reliant India Mission) is a framework for building a self-reliant India, which would be competitive globally. It is also looking to strengthen local manufacturing, build local supply chains, and convert local products into global brands. This Abhiyan also had a major agenda of being a nation of job-creators and not just-seekers.

The Government of India is trying hard to best utilize the power of youth in new startups to achieve the target of self-reliant India, so it is high time to encourage and motivate young volunteers. This seminar provided a platform to distinguish experts in the field and delegates from different institutes to deliberate on the given topic. In the seminar, a total of 102 delegates from different states of India including Haryana, Punjab, Kerala, Tamilnadu, Madhya Pradesh and Himachal Pradesh got registered and 60 delegates (including individual and joint presentations) presented 38 research papers.

The inaugural session was graced by Dr. Samar Singh, Vice-chancellor, Maharana Pratap University of Horticulture, Karnal as Chief Guest and Dr. Anil Vashishth, Dean Student Welfare and Nodal Officer of Atmanirbhar Haryana, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana as the Keynote Speaker.

Before officially starting the proceedings of the session, a tree plantation was done by the distinguished guests of the day. The NSS volunteers of the college welcomed the distinguished guests and delegates by putting a 'Chandan Tilak' due to summer season representing the heritage cultural knowledgeof India. The inaugural session started with the lighting of the divine lamp by the worthy guests along with Principal of the college, NSS Programme Officers Dr. Dimple Khosla, Dr. Tejpal and Dr. Rubi.

Dr. Ashima Gakhar, Principal of the college, welcomed the guests with the planters and presented a brief introduction of the Chief Guest- Dr. Samar Singh and Keynote Speaker-Dr. Anil Vashishth. She told the audience that as a preliminary part of this seminar, the college celebrated World Youth Skill Day on July 15th, 2022 by organizing various skill based competitions for school students like Poster Making, Slogan Writing and Rangoli Making. These creations were exhibited on the day of the Seminar. She also gave an overview of various skill based stalls that were exhibited to showcase the live examples of Atmanirbhar Bharat. She said that NSS units of our college always tries to build an environment that not only enhances the feeling of social responsibility but also gives the volunteers an encouragement to become a 'VOLUNTEER' in real sense. She congratulated and gave her best wishes to the NSS team for organizing this seminar and for selecting such a relevant topic for the deliberation.

Dr. Dimple Khosla, NSS Program Officer and Convener of this seminar introduced the theme. She said that NSS volunteers are young Indians and they represent the most dynamic and vibrant section of the Society. If the power of students is directed to constructive purposes, the whole nation will move to all round development. Our youth is full of skills, the only need is to

recognize and channelize their skills and energy. Now, a number of path-breaking initiatives have been taken like 'Make in India', 'Digital India', 'Skill India' and much more. The students/volunteers and the youth of our country are indulging in these activities with much enthusiasm. So, these volunteers can be contributors as well as beneficiaries of all these initiatives started by the Indian Government to achieve the target of Self-Reliant India. She also said that this Seminar has been organized with the objective of discussing the emerging issues, potential areas, problems and challenges related to Atmanirbhar Bharat.

In his inaugural address, Dr. Samar Singh emphasized that new opportunities for employment and self-employment can be created through skill-development. We can take India to new heights by self-employment. He described the indigenous model of Indian economy as the need of the hour. Dr. Samar pointed out that while learning we should earn something in student life itself, the sooner we learn to earn, the more confidence we will get and we will become self-reliant. He raised the issue of 'Food availability' as the most important need of human beings. He quoted an example of cultivation of mushrooms for being self reliant. He said that Mushroom is a business that can be started with nominal funds and if successful, the mushroom production can be augmented at any stage. Though, the mushroom is rich in nutrition value, still the consumption of mushrooms is only 100 grams per person in our country, whereas, in the Netherlands and China, it is used widely. The price of the latest variety of mushrooms is high in the market, and their production can help farmers earn a good income. Prof. Samar Singh said that the farmers should also be informed about economic analysis and marketing of mushrooms. He also discussed some of the successful stories of farmers who

raised their status by growing mushrooms. Dr. Anil Vashishth in his keynote address emphasized the importance and role of youth in the successful implementation of the initiatives taken by Honorable Prime Minister of India to achieve the goal of self-reliant India. He said that we have to work on the ground to inculcate the spirit of indigenous self-reliance among the youth and make Haryana poverty free and fully employable. Employment-oriented education and policies have to be made and our New Education Policy is an important step in this direction. He said that there is a need to find out the potential ideas from the young generation that could be converted into small ventures and for that we should arrange small workshops for the students in which they come forward with their ideas, demonstrate these and they get the proper training for starting their venture.

A special session was conducted under the chairmanship of Dr. Rajbir Singh Gulia, General Manager, Dyal Singh College Trust Society to practically impart knowledge of some aspects regarding skill-based ventures. In this session, Mr. M.K. Verma, Assistant Director, Micro Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), Karnal-Ludhiana Division, who was the guest speaker of the session, told about various schemes of Government of India available for promoting skill based ventures for young entrepreneurs. He told step by step the procedure of availing these schemes. After that Mr. Sunil, an entrepreneur from Panipat elaborated his startup of essential oils.

At the end of the inaugural session, a Felicitation ceremony was done for the guests and a formal vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. Jai Kumar, Assistant Professor of Hindi and Coordinator of the seminar. Thereafter, the session was called for a tea break.

Then the exhibition of skill based stalls was inaugurated by the guests and the Principal of the College by cutting the ribbon. Dr. Tejpal, organizing Secretary of the seminar presented these stalls which were showcased in the college campus for encouraging and motivating the youth to engage themselves in income generating skill based activities. These stalls were appreciated by the guests and all the delegates. Dr. Anil Vashishth said that this is actually the need of the hour to not just stick to the lectures but also to give the live examples of the Atmanirbhar Bharat.

Due to huge participation two technical sessions were conducted at two different venues before lunch. First Technical Session was chaired by Dr. Rajesh Turan, Associate Professor, DAV College, Pundri and Co-chaired by Dr. Deepti Sharma, Assistant Professor, KVADAV College for Women, Karnal. Second Technical Session was Chaired by Dr. Manoj Kumar, Assistant Professor, DAV College, Pehowa and Co-chaired by Dr Seema Pandey, Assistant Professor, Govt. College, Palwal, Kurukshetra. Various research papers were presented by the delegates covering the topics like Youth and Start-ups, Local for vocal, Brain Drain or Brain gain, Make in India initiative, Skill India etc. The different papers covered almost every sub theme of the seminar. During the sessions various constructive issues were raised by the participants. After the presentations, Chairpersons reviewed the presentations and gave their concluding remarks as well as suggestions to the presenters for further improvements. After the completion, both the sessions were dispersed for the lunch.

In the Valedictory session, Dr. Brijpal, Deputy Director, Director General Higher Education, Panchkula was the Chief Guest and Dr. D.S. Rana, NSS Coordinator, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra was the Guest of Honour.



This session was also started with the Tree Plantation by the guests and the Principal. To start formally, Dr. Ashima Gakhar, Principal of the college presented a floral welcome to the guests and introduced them to the delegates. Dr. Rubi, Organizing Secretary of the seminar presented the detailed report of the Seminar.

Dr. D.S. Rana, NSS Coordinator, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra spoke about the various efforts that can be taken by NSS volunteers to make India self-reliant. He said that the glow of a volunteer should be reflected in his personality and said that in self-reliant India, the role of youth's determination and strong self-confidence will be the most important.

Dr. Brijpal in his valedictory address highlighted the main aspect of the theme of the seminar and emphasized the relevance of the topic in the present time. He said that when a person is himself enlightened, he gives light to the entire world. He quoted some motivational stories of NSS volunteers who have taken initiatives in different startups. He told in detail how they made it possible to arrange finance and develop their own models to stand out in this competitive world. This is the inspiration for India becoming self-reliant.

Dr. Seema Pandey, delegate and Ms. Renu, Student participant gave the feedback of the seminar on behalf of the participants and congratulated the organizers for organizing such a wonderful seminar. They said that the eminent personalities who spoke today had enlightened everyone with their knowledge and wisdom. The outcome of this seminar will definitely be fruitful and beneficial for the society at large.

Detail of Activities Performed on Day-1

The camp venue i.e. Langar Hall was cleaned and decorated by the volunteers. For the auspicious start of the camp. Dr. Basant Kumar, former head of the Sanskrit department, performed **Havan** in the camp and told that by doing any auspicious work, our mental balance remains. Detail of Activities Performed on Day-2

The second day started with performing Yogasanas under the supervision of Dr. Rajyashree, Former Head, Department of Sanskrit, DAV (PG) College, Karnal. She said that yoga can help us maintain not only a healthy body but also a healthy mind. She also shared some yoga postures which students can teach to elders at their home to get rid of joint pain and other age-related problems. The goal during a yoga practice is to challenge yourself physically, but not feel overwhelmed, she said. Your focus should be on your breath while your mind is still.

In the second session, Advocate Amit Sachdeva, District Court, Karnal shared with the students, examples of how Cybercrimes are committed and various ways to safeguard oneself against such crimes. He said that there are various techniques to identify cybercrime catchers and also illegal websites which try to take data and use it to commit fraud. And he asked students to be a little cautious about messages or emails asking for personal details as this is the best way to avoid becoming a victim of cybercrime. He took up the second topic of Gender Inequality. He said that if the girls themselves take the initiative and resolve not to take dowry, then parents can make them as capable as men by spending the same money on their education instead of adding to their dowry. He also talked about the rights given to women.

Dr. Rajyashree and Advocate Amit flagged off the Farmer's Awareness Rally on **Stubble Management**. The volunteers made the villagers aware about the various ill effects of burning the crop residue. There the students interacted with the villagers and told them about

the various ways by which they can avoid burning the crop residue and use it in the field as fertiliser.

After lunch Dr. Vivek Gakhar, Anesthesiologist did a Demonstration on CPR and Cardiac Massage keeping in view the recent increase in cardiac arrest and deaths due to cardiac issues. Dr. Vivek Gakhar said that sudden cardiac arrest is the abrupt loss of heart function and survival from cardiac arrest largely depends on how quickly CPR is started and the quality of CPR given. Hands-Only CPR has just two simple steps, performed in this order: Call 9-11 if you see a teen or adult suddenly collapse and push hard and fast in center of chest to the beat of a familiar song that has 100 to 120 beats per minute. He said that the knowledge of such techniques can help save hundreds of lives. He explained the nuances to keep in mind, the dos and don'ts of getting a person breathing again. After this, he got the students to practise CPR on dummy bodies by making them practise it. In the night session volunteers played some games for their recreation.



Detail of Activities Performed on Day-3

The third day started with prayer, yoga and meditation. In the second session, the Department of Fire and Emergency Services was invited to give a demonstration. A team of District Assistant Fire Officer Shri Ram Kumar came to the camp with fire engine and professional fire safety equipment to sensitise the students about life saving and rescue techniques in case of fire. Firefighters demonstrated **Rescue Operations during fire accidents** in oil, gas and electrical equipment. They also explained how a spark of fire can turn into a major fire accident and how to act on such occasions to extinguish the fire without panic. The objective of this exercise was to create awareness among the students about **fire-fighting techniques** and ways to react swiftly in time of any emergency. All the students witnessed the **drill** and learned about the importance of fire emergency preparedness.

Professor KDS Bedi, Pro-Vice Chancellor of Chitkara University Chandigarh inspired the volunteers with the live examples to be focused, dedicated and consistent. He told them to learn the importance of time management. He also listed various avenues that can be explored by the students for higher education their graduation. Volunteers then visited the village and helped the villagers in their work.

In the afternoon session, a team of Legal Literacy Cell from the college visited the camp to organise Slogan and Poster Making Competitions. 20 volunteers prepared posters on the topics such as-Women Empowerment, Drug De-addiction and Evil of Ragging, and 8 volunteers prepared slogans on the topics of Legal Awareness, Fundamental Rights & Duties and Hygiene and Cleanliness. 
































Detail of Activities Performed on Day-6
