

Entrepreneurship awareness programme on “Converting Hobby into Business”

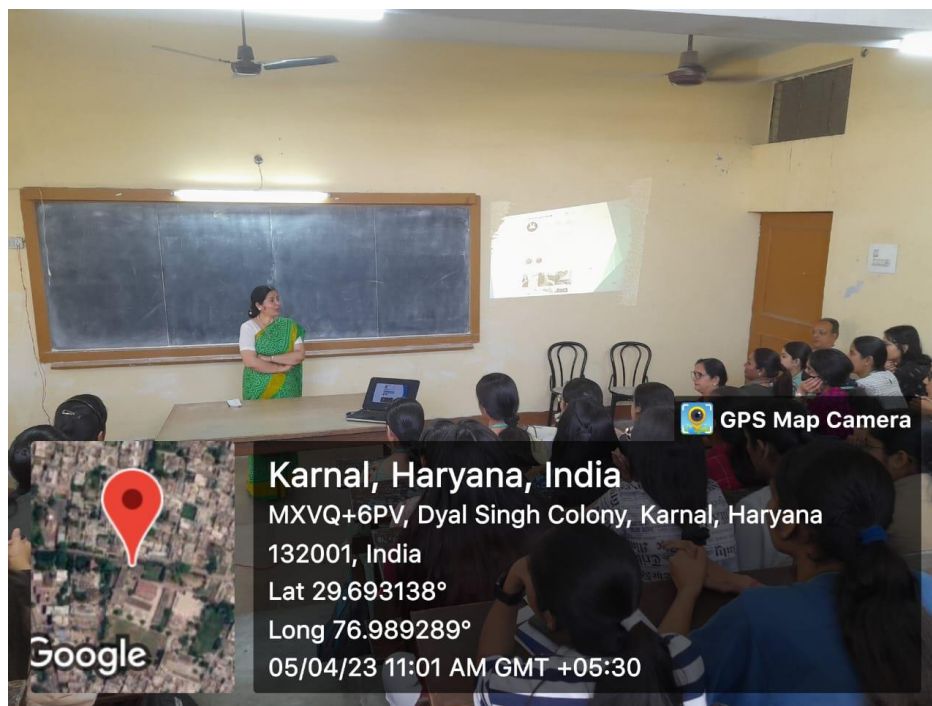
(1st Quarter Event, Start-Up Committee, IIC)
